Right at the beginning of John's Gospel, there is no doubt about who Jesus is, for as Jesus is calling his first disciples Nathanael almost immediately says that Jesus is the Son of God. Jesus, while not being critical of Nathanael's faith, tells him that his faith journey has only begun and that he will see "greater things" than what he already has. 
Lift Every Voice and Sing

Poet James Weldon Johnson was the first African-American to pass the bar examination in the state of Florida, and served as U.S. consul in Venezuela and Nicaragua. He collaborated with his composer brother, John Rosamond Johnson, to write Broadway operettas and edit song collections. John appeared in vaudeville, directed London musicals, and headed the Music School Settlement in New York.

Acts 4:32-35; 1 Cor. 1:26-31; 1 Pet. 3:8-12




