### MESSAGE

"Lifted Up"

John makes an amazing parallel between Jesus and the serpent that Moses makes during the journey through the wilderness. Just like the Israelites on the Exodus, the people during Jesus' time were in their own wilderness: one of bondage under Rome and a spiritual one of being "lost". Jesus' own people grow impatient for a time of liberation and of freedom, just as the ancient Israelites grew impatient. In order to give the ancient Israelites hope that God was still with them, God had Moses lift up the serpent. Now, that same hope is found in Jesus; lifted up in our midst as the Word made flesh. Those who believe that are given Life. Do we recognize that God is still with us, still speaking, and lifted up in our midst?


