The Angel Tree

The Angel Tree is a custom that FCCWP practices every year at Christmas. The tree benefits children living at the Great Oaks Children's Home and LGBTQ youth at the Zebra Coalition.

Great Oaks is a residential foster group home for children ages 6-18 who have been removed from their homes by the court. The facility is run by the Florida Department of Children and Family Services. Usually there are 40-50 children living in the home at any one time. We get a list of the children at Great Oaks that includes their age, their gender, the cottage they live in, and their top two gift wishes. Church members provide the requested gift for each child.

We also do gift certificates that the home is free to decide how these

gift certificates are best used. They may be used to help an aging out teen to set up a home or to help Great Oaks make acquisitions to better serve the youth. We are planning six Great Oaks Aging Out Baskets that include household items like kitchen towels, soap, dishes, cookware, etc. as well as hygiene items that are placed into the laundry baskets and given to teens aging out to help set up their new homes.

We are continuing a tradition started in 2019, providing \$25 gift cards for Zebra Coalition youth. LGBTQ youth ages 13-24 will be provided a gift card for the holiday. Zebra Coalition helps with housing for about forty youth, but the coalition also serves many more teens with counseling and other services. COVID 19 has put these youth at greater risk.

FCCWP Angel Tree 2021 and the Zebra Coalition Gifts will be virtual. All gift items are on Sign-up Genius for you to select one or multiple items that you will provide. Our ask is that the commitment is honored so that no child is left without a gift. Just drop off at the main office after church or any normal business day during business hours

- 2. Get your chosen gift/s for the youth.
- 3. Attach the e-mail confirmation to the gift from Genius and drop off at the First Congregational Church of Winter Park main office no later than December 19 during normal business hours or after church. We must have these gifts no later than December 19 11:30 am.



ELIZABETH HOOKER BOOK CLUB DECEMBER

The book club will not be meeting for December. The next meeting is January 23rd when we will be sharing Linda Sue Parks *A Long Walk to Water*.

A Long Walk to Water begins as two stories, told in alternating sections, about a girl in Sudan in 2008 and a boy in Sudan in 1985. The girl, Nya, is fetching water from a pond that is two hours' walk from her home: she makes two trips to the pond every day. The boy, Salva, becomes one of the "lost boys" of Sudan, refugees who cover the African continent on foot as they search for their families and for a safe place to stay. Enduring every hardship from loneliness to attack by armed rebels to contact with killer lions and crocodiles, Salva is a survivor, and his story goes on to intersect with Nya's in an astonishing and moving way.
