

The class studies spiritual teachings and practices from Christianity and other world religions. Currently the class is studying the Gospel of Mark by reading together Marcus Borg's book, *Meeting Jesus in Mark*. On alternate Sundays, lessons come from Thich Nhat Hahn's book, *Going Home: Jesus and Buddha as Brothers*. The intention of the class is to broaden participants' knowledge of theological and spiritual concepts and to acquaint spiritual seekers with practical skills for living happy, calm, ethical, and meaningful lives.

Current Events




ACOLYTES WANTED!
