

SILENT MEDITATION

"I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34-35

"Maundy" is the English form of the Latin word meaning "commandment." Jesus' new commandment to "love one another" is the focus of Maundy Thursday. This love is demonstrated in Jesus' example of servanthood as he knelt down and washed his disciples' feet and in the gift of Jesus' offering of Self in the breaking of bread and the pouring of the cup in Holy Communion.
