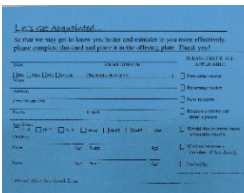
# WELCOME






FCCWP will have 29 Adults, Youth & Children heading to SD June 2025 representing the caring hearts of all the members of our church.


## Sweet Hour of Prayer


